NOTE: 36 Car Limit (Entry fee accepted in advance. NO REFUNDS. 1st 36 cars only.)

1. Cars will be divided into 3 heats with 4 cars in each heat qualifying for the feature event.
2. **No time will be allowed** after the 3rd heat to work on cars before the feature event.

SATURDAY NIGHT

NOTE: Only 20 New Cars Will Be accepted Sat. Night

(Entry fee accepted in advance. NO REFUNDS. 1st 20 cars only.)

1. All cars entered in Friday night event will be eligible to run Sat. night with no entry fee. (Cars not running by 5:00 pm Sat. will be removed from pit area.)
2. Cars will be divided into 3 heats with 4 cars in each heat qualifying for the feature event. **(May vary with judges decision)**
3. **No time will be allowed** after the 3rd heat to work on cars before the feature event.

**FRIDAY & SATURDAY : Top 4 From Each Heat - \$100.00 & Trophy
Feature Winner - \$800.00 & Trophy • Runner Up - \$400.00 & Trophy**

SUNDAY NIGHT

COMPACT CARS - Note: First 15 Cars ONLY. Entry fee accepted in advance.

Rules & Regulations are the same as full size except a maximum wheel base of 104 inches. One Heat Only.

Winner - \$400 & Trophy Runner-Up - \$200 & Trophy (if participation is adequate)

NOTE: Fuel tank rule does not apply to compact cars.

GRUDGE MATCH - No entry fee

Any car participating Friday or Saturday night is eligible. Winner \$400 & Trophy Runner-up \$200 & Trophy. The Purse for Compact and Grudge Match will be set at \$100 per car with a limit of \$600 each payout, prorated.

Example: 3 Entries, Purse \$300 — Winners share \$200 / Runner-up \$100

• RULES AND REGULATIONS •

1. DRIVERS MUST BE 18 YEARS OF AGE. **16 & 17 year olds may enter with official release form signed by parent or guardian.**
2. ALL DRIVERS AND CARS must be entered and at the track 1 hour before the scheduled starting time of derby.
3. ANY DRIVER NOT OBEYING THE RULES WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.
4. YOUR CAR NUMBER WILL BE ISSUED ON APPROVAL OF YOUR APPLICATION.
Numbers must be on each side of your car in large, bright colors.
5. EACH DRIVER MUST FILL OUT ENTRY BLANK.
6. ALL RULES AND REGULATIONS MUST BE OBSERVED.
Track operators or promoter reserves the right to approve or reject any and all entries.
7. ONLY OWNERS, DRIVERS OR MECHANICS WILL be permitted in the pit area or on the track. This covers drivers and mechanics. No more than 3 people permitted per car in pit area. Names of Driver and 2 Pit Crew Members MUST be submitted with entry blank for free entry. ALL others pay admission price.
8. THE ENTRY FEE MUST BE CASH OR MONEY ORDER. **Fee \$25.00**
NO PERSONAL CHECKS.
9. NO CARS permitted on the track before the heat they are to participate in.
10. **NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES allowed in pits. A random sobriety test will be given to drivers—failure to take the test if asked, will mean immediate disqualification. Of course, if intoxicated you will not be allowed to drive.**
11. MAXIMUM TIRES SIZE 7:00 x 15, 6 ply.
12. NO CHRYSLER IMPERIALS, HEARSEs or LIMOUSINES allowed.
13. ALL CARS MUST BE REMOVED FROM GROUNDS BY THE OWNER NO LATER THAN 6:00 P.M. MONDAY, SEPT. 22ND, OR THEY BECOME THE PROPERTY OF THE FAIRGROUNDS-NO EXCEPTIONS.
14. No trucks, jeeps. etc. will be allowed.
15. ALL GLASS AND CHROME TRIM AND ANYTHING THAT MIGHT BECOME IMBEDDED in the track, must be removed from the car before bringing auto to the grounds. Also car must be cleaned out including the trunk. Don't leave broken glass in doors, clean them out. WINDSHIELD IS OPTIONAL.
16. A maximum of five (5) gallons of gas will be allowed. Gas tanks must be moved to inside car and covered by a firewall. All gas tanks left on the car must be empty with visible hole in bottom of tank to prove it. Tank can be removed completely. ONLY 1 STOCK CAR BATTERY WILL BE ALLOWED.
17. SAFETY BELTS AND HELMETS ARE REQUIRED. All doors must be welded shut or tied with rope or wire. If a driver's side door comes open, he will be disqualified.
18. DRIVERS MAY MANEUVER FORWARD OR BACKWARD. No deliberate head-on collisions or deliberately ramming driver's door. This can lead to disqualification.
19. A TIME LIMIT WILL BE SET BY THE JUDGES. IF A DRIVER DOES NOT HIT A LIVE CAR WITHIN THE TIME LIMIT, this can lead to disqualification. DO NOT PLAY POSSUM!
20. DO NOT weld or bolt hoods or trunk lids down. Use wire or light chain.
21. A 12 by 15 INCH HOLE must be cut in the center of the hood.
22. SAFETY RULES AND REGULATIONS ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE TO FIT THE EVENT. THE DECISION OF THE JUDGES IS FINAL.
23. **NEW REINFORCEMENT RULES - Now allow for 1 horizontal brace in front and behind drivers compartment, inside driver door, inside passenger door, and 1 in middle to connect front and back to create a box for drivers protection. Maximum 4" tubing and all welds must be of professional quality—if not you will be disqualified.**
24. **NO Vertical Braces or other reinforcements are allowed.**
25. **IMPORTANT NEW SAFETY RULES - If a driver breaks his flag, do not hit his car. If a car is not moving, do not take aim at the driver's compartment from any direction. A violation of either can lead to disqualification.**
